Selwyn Piper	A successful literary critic and thriller writer. He is well groomed, self-assured with a ready and somewhat sardonic wit. He is divorced from Imogen. He has a British accent.	40 to 60
Christine Scott	Selwyn's secretary. A likeable and efficient female who displays unobtrusive charm. Any accent will work well.	20 to 30
Imogen Piper	The ex-wife. She's an attractive ex-actress displaying theatrical charm and composure. She and Selwyn verbally fence with each other. This is a fun and challenging role. Two British accents, preferably one of which is Scottish.	30 to 50
Peter Fletcher	He appears frivolous and light-hearted in nature. He is quite acute when the time comes. He lives next door to Selwyn. Any accent will work well.	30 to 50
John Douglas Selwyn's publisher. An immaculately turned-out bachelor with an easy charm which deteriorates into bewilderment under stress. He is intellectually inferior to Imogen and Selwyn. He has a British accent.		40 to 60
